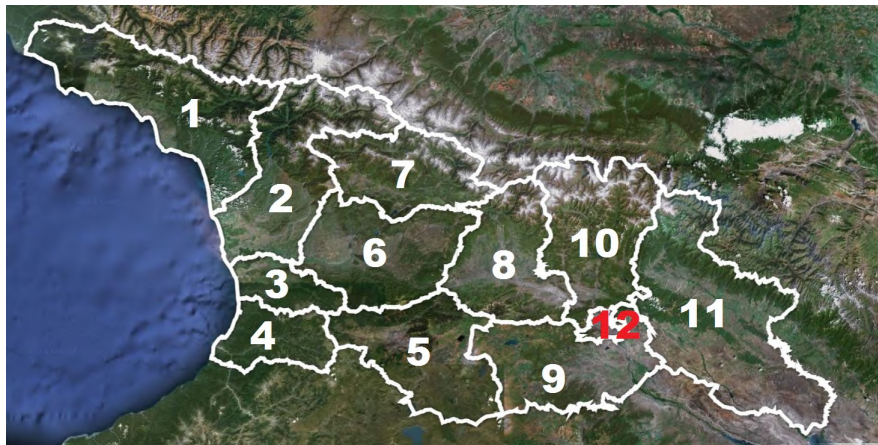


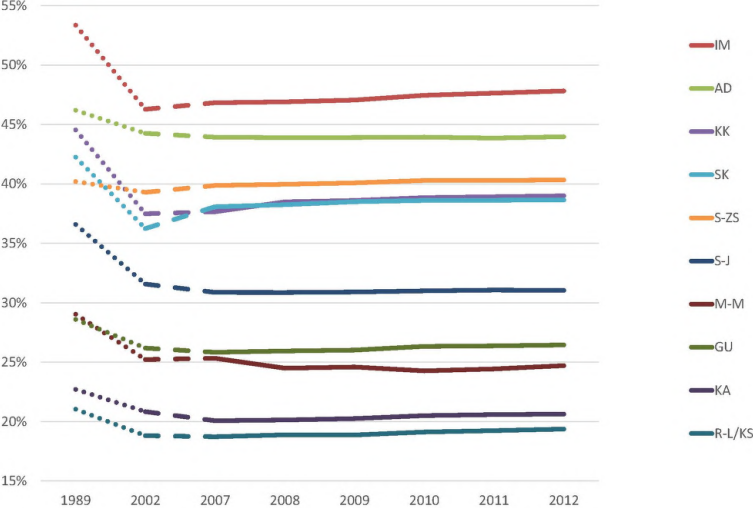

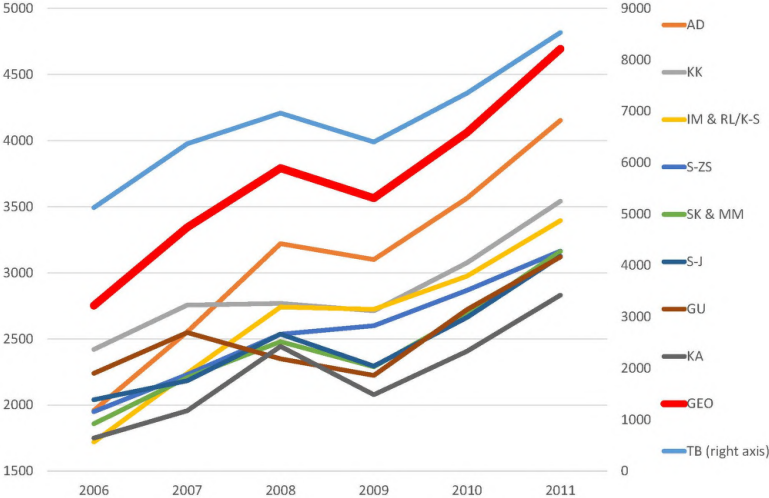
# Urbanization Rates



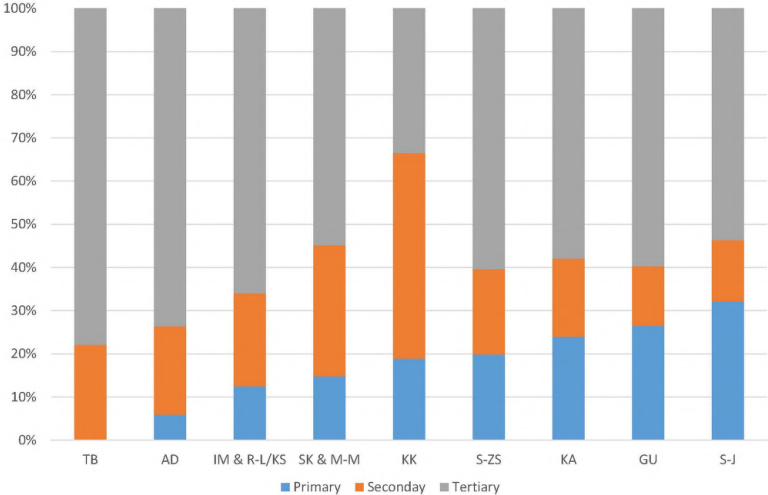

USA	States	31.6%	8.9%

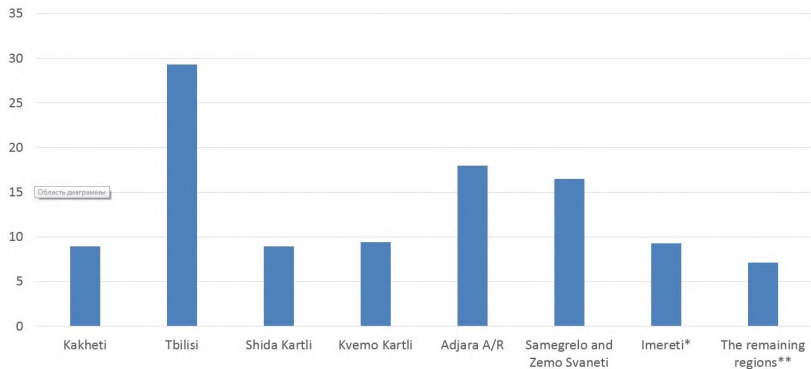
# Per Capita Gross Value Added



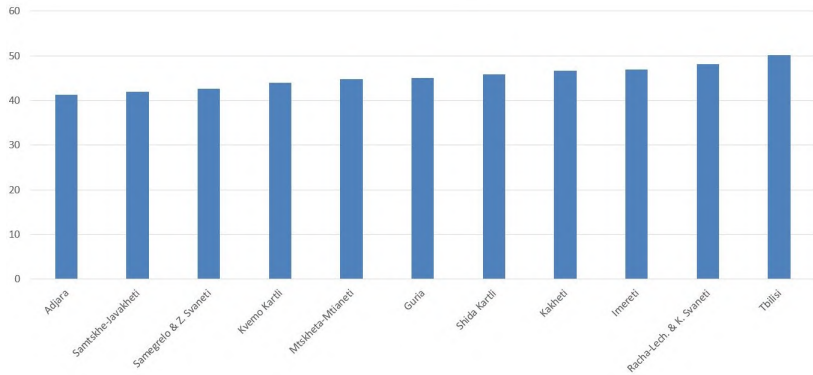

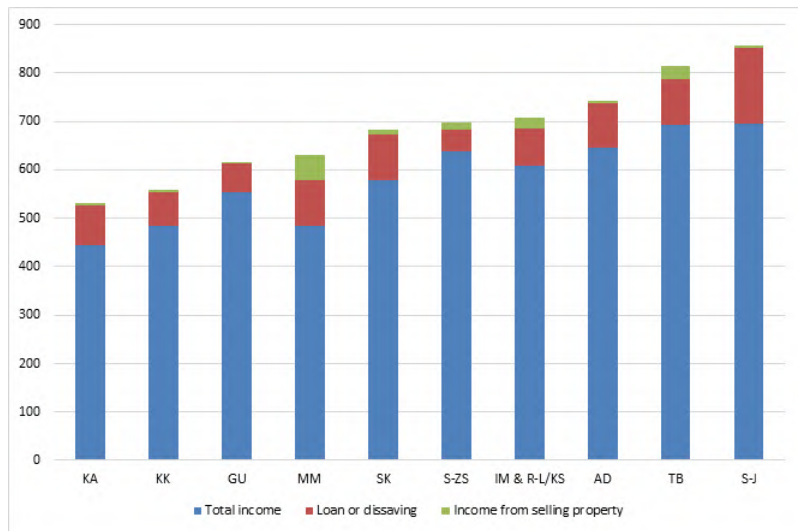


# National Exam Scores

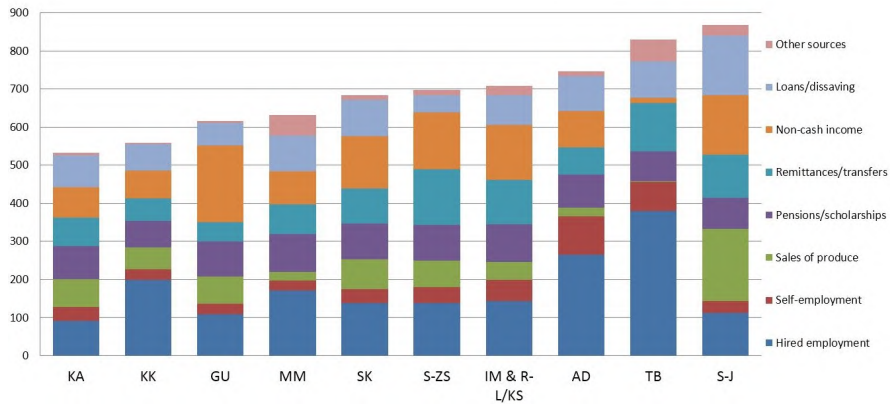




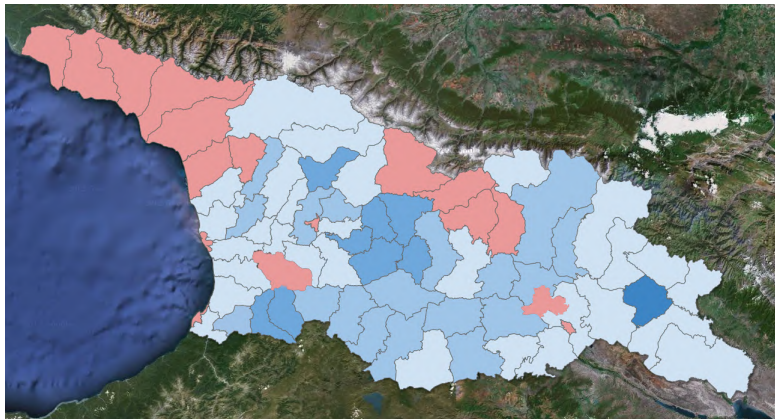
# Per Capita Income
